

Storing Rifles

Here's what to do: Get some **Super Lube spray**. This stuff is an aerosol lubricant. It goes on as a liquid, but then it hardens into a thin grease.

Use the extension tube to spray a long blast of **Super Lube** down the bore. **Super Lube** also comes in a tube. The stuff in a tube is a synthetic teflon infused grease. You should simply wipe the exposed metal down with this grease and you are done.

You can then wrap the rifle up with a little butcher's paper and sock the gun away in your safe.

And check up on the rifle every year or so. At one point the entire Squinty Arsenal was in storage for 5 years. **Super Lube** protected the metal and we did not have even one speck of rust.
