Signs and Symptoms of Exposure: Eyes and Skin Irritation.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures: Flush eyes and skin with large amounts of water until irritation subsides. If inhaled, remove victim from exposure and give artificial respiration if breathing has stopped, if ingested Do Not induce vomiting, seek prompt medical attention.

SECTION VII - PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

Steps to be taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled: Contain the material. Absorb with dirt or sand, remove to waste container and flush area with water. Do not allow liquid to enter sewers, or waterways.

Waste Disposal Method: Do not allow liquid to enter sewers, or waterways. Dispose of in compliance with Federal, State and Local laws and regulations.

Precautions to be taken in Handling and Storage: Avoid contact with eyes and wash thoroughly after handling. Store in a cool, well ventilated place away from incompatible materials.

Other Precautions: Do not weld or cut empty containers. Do not reuse empty containers without commercial cleaning or reconditioning.

SECTION VIII - CONTROL MEASURES

Respiratory Protection (*Specify Type*) None required.

Ventilation: Use ventilation equipment to control PEL.
